Tender Notice

Cost of tender Rs.500/-

Sealed tenders affixed with revenue stamps worth Rs.5/- (Rs. Five only) are invited for and on behalf of Governor of J&K State from the reputed manufacturers / duly authorized dealers/Government undertakings registered suppliers regarding supply of different types of Machineries required for S.M.Farm Chinore and Potato Dev Scheme Jammu.

Terms and conditions

- 1** The tenders should reach the office of the undersigned by or before 15-10-2011 by 03.00 P.M through speed post / courier/ by hand. Tenders brought by hand shall be put in a TENDER BOX by the concerned tenderer in the office of the undersigned on any working day during office hours up to the said date and time. In case of any gazetted holiday falling on the last date of receipt of tenders or some holiday suddenly declared by the competent authority under Negotiable Instrument Act , the next working day shall be treated as the last date of receipt of tenders
- 2** The tenders should be accompanied with a C.D.R. ^{/FDR} of 2% of cost of the materials to be supplied subject to minimum of the amount of Rs.10000/- on any scheduled bank pledged to Accounts Officer (Member Secretary SLRCFC) Department of Agriculture, J&K Govt., Talab Tillo-Jammu.
- 3** The tenders should be neatly written in ink with rates in figures and words. Cutting or overwriting on quoted rates shall not be entertained unless authenticated. Cello tapes be applied on the written rates of tender.
- 4** Technical Bid and Financial Bid should be submitted in accordance with prescribed Annexure C & D (enclosed) on your letter head in separate sealed envelopes. Further both the envelopes be sealed properly and packed in a single cover of convenient size before dispatching the same by post/courier or putting the same in the tender box duly super scribed as "**Tender for supply of Agriculture** addressed to Chairman State Level Rate Contract Finalization Committee, Department of Agriculture Talab Tillo Jammu J&K State. The under mentioned documents / detail must be submitted with your technical offer.
 - A Registration Certificate (VAT) of tenderer
 - B C.D.R / FDR Pledged to Accounts Officer (Member Secretary SLRCFC) Department of Agriculture, J&K Govt., Talab Tillo-Jammu
 - C Relevant technical literature of the product for which the rates are quoted.
 - D Details of after-sales-service facilities available
 - E Details of warranty
 - F Details of users and copies of the user certificates of the proposed model / make of Machineries.
 - H Valid CST/VAT and Pan Card copy should be enclosed
- 5** Rates quoted MUST be for delivery on F.O.R. Jammu basis.
- 6** Comprehensive on site warranty for a minimum period of **two years** from the date of satisfactory installation, commissioning and final acceptance for any manufacturing defect that may crop up in the machinery to be supplied by them The warranty clause on these lines **MUST** be



clearly mentioned on both technical and commercial bids. Details of warranty/guarantee and the after-sales service facilities available in destination must be specifically mentioned in your offer.

- 7 The payment shall be released in favour of the firm after installation, run and the satisfactory functioning of the procured machinery.
- 8 The firm from whom the machinery is procured shall make available the spare parts as and when requisitioned by the intending officer.
- 9 The item should be delivered and commissioned within 20 days from the date of confirm supply order. Delivery period required by you MUST be clearly mentioned in your offer.
- 10 Your offer MUST be valid for a minimum period of **Ninety days** from the date of opening of technical bids.
- 11 90% payment shall be made only after verification regarding installation and commissioning and final acceptance of supply of machinery and 10% after ninety days from the date of commissioning.
- 12 The tenders will be opened by the State Level Rate Contract Finalization Committee (SLRCFC) on the same day, or any other working day convenient to the members of the Committee, in presence of tenderers or their representatives who wish to remain present at the time of opening of tenders
- 13 The S.L.R.C.F.C. reserves the right to accept or reject any tender, part of a tender, or all tenders without assigning any reason thereto
- 14 Conditional tenders shall not be entertained
- 15 Each of copy of the tender should be a complete document and should preferably be bound
- 16 The vendor should quote the rates inclusive of all taxes and duties as per performa


- 17 Authorized dealer may attach **Dealership certificate** from the Principal manufacturers.
- 18 The successful tenderer shall have to supply the materials within the time schedule given by the Department. In case of failure to execute the job, the Department shall be at liberty to arrange the material at the risk and cost of successful tenderer and forfeiting the C.D.R, besides initiating legal proceedings against the successful tenderer (s) as warranted under rules. In case, the extra cost involved exceeds the CDR amount, the same will be recovered from the defaulting supplier through Land Revenues Act
- 19 The successful tenderer shall have to enter into an agreement on prescribed performa on non judicial stamp paper of Rs.20/- with the indenting officer before the supply order is issued in his favour for effecting supplies.
- 20 Rates approved by SLRCFC shall remain valid for one year from the date of issue of minutes of meeting.
- 21 The tenderer shall have to produce a copy of Commercial Tax Clearance certificate issued by the concerned assessing authorities for the period ending March 2011 alongwith tender documents or before finalization of the rates.
- 22 Copy of electric tariff clearance ending March 2011, issued by Power Development Department shall have to be produced by successful tenderers before release of payment by Indenting Officer
- 23 Doubt/ dispute/ differences arising out of contract entered into between the parties will be referred to Convener S.L.R.C.F.C. Agriculture Department Jammu for decision under J&K Arbitration Act, whose decision shall be final and binding on both parties.
- 24 Legal proceedings, if any, are subject to the jurisdiction of the courts located in the Jammu city,

- 25 Tender without payment of tender cost shall be summarily rejected

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




