

Sealed tenders affixed with revenue stamps worth Rs.5/- (Rs. Five only) are invited for and on behalf of Governor of J&K State from the manufacturers / registered and duly authorized dealers/Government undertakings having valid manufacturer license and license under Insecticide Act 1968 issued by competent authority regarding supply Plant Protection Chemicals for Jammu and Kashmir Division of J&K State as per specifications given in annexure "A" to this NIT,

Terms and condition

1	The tenders should reach the office of the undersigned by or before 22-09-2011 by 01.00 P.M through speed post / courier/ by hand. Tenders brought by hand shall be put in a TENDER BOX by the concerned tenderer in the office of the undersigned on any working day during office hours up to the said date and time. In case of any gazetted holiday falling on the last date of receipt of tenders or some holiday suddenly declared by the competent authority under Negotiable Instrument Act , the next working day shall be treated as the last date of receipt of tenders
2	S.S.I. Unit holders should attach C.D.R., as applicable under rules. Beside they shall attach copy of valid Registration/functioning certificate issued by the General Manager Industries Department of the concerned district of J&K State.
3	Tenders should be accompanied with the technical literature/brochure/pamphlet of the product for which the rates are quoted.
4	The tenders should be accompanied with a fresh C.D.R./FDR of 2% of cost of the materials to be supplied subject to a minimum amount of Rs.15000.00 on any scheduled bank pledged to Accounts Officer (Member Secretary SLRCFC) Department of Agriculture, J&K Govt., Talab Tillo-Jammu.
5	The tenders should be neatly written in ink with rates in figures and words. Cutting or overwriting on quoted rates shall not be entertained unless authenticated. Cello tapes be applied on the rates quoted by the tenderer.
6	Copy of valid license under Insecticide Act 1968 issued by competent authority may be attached.
7	In case of manufacturer , a photocopy of the manufacturer license may be attached. A photocopy of the manufacturer license and authorization for dealership in case of trader/supplier be attached..
8	Sealed tenders under two bid system should be as under: a) Technical Bid : consisting of item wise all technical detail (as per proforma B, enclosed) b) Financial Bid : Indicating item wise price (as per proforma C, enclosed)
9	Technical Bid (marked as cover I), and Financial Bid (marked as cover II), should be submitted in accordance with prescribed Annexure B & C (enclosed) on letter head, in separate sealed envelopes, duly super scribed " Tender for supply of Plant Protection Chemicals ". Both of these covers, as well as cover IIIrd containing Earnest Money (EMD) are to be put in a main cover of convenient size, which should be sealed properly duly super scribed as " Tender for supply of Plant Protection Chemicals addressed to Chairman State Level Rate Contract Finalization Committee, Department of Agriculture Talab Tillo Jammu J&K State before dispatching the same by post/courier or putting the same in the tender box.
10	Documents required as mention in Annexure B, must be submitted with the technical bid.
11	The item should be delivered and commissioned within 25 days. Delivery period required by the tenderer MUST be clearly mentioned in the offer.
12	The offer MUST be valid for a minimum period of Ninety days from the date of opening of



	technical bids.
13	The successful tenderer shall be responsible for proper packing of the material to be supplied to avoid damage under normal conditions of transport and delivery of the material in good condition to the consignee at destination. In the event of any damage, or shortage, the tenderer shall be liable to make good such loss at the time of checking/inspection of the material by the consignee. No extra cost shall be admissible on such account.
14	All material must be labeled, sealed as prescribed under Insecticides Act 1968, and rules made thereof and amended up to date.
15	Authorized representative of the Agriculture Department shall have reasonable time, access to the supplier's premises and power to inspect and examine the stores and stocks of the supplies to be made.
16	Net content of the supplies offered should conform to the terms of weight / volume inscribed on the label, failing which the supplier shall replace the entire quantity supplied, or make good the shortage as the case may be including all other expenditure which the department may have incurred by way of carriage, loading unloading etc.
17	The suppliers shall depute their representatives to be present before an authorized committee of the Department for drawing samples of their stocks supplied to the Department at the first destination of supply for drawing of samples for quantitative/qualitative analysis. The samples drawn by the said Authorized committee shall have to be signed by the same committee of the Department and the authorized representative of the suppliers. In case the authorized representative of the supplier does not turn up for the purpose within stipulated time, of the material will be drawn by the authorized committee and sent for analysis unilaterally Department. Afterwards, no plea from supplier shall be entertained in this regard. The sampling done on the same day or any other day convenient to the committee, after receipt of supplies in the Departmental store. One sample will be retained by the supplier, 2nd by the consignee, 3 rd . will be utilized for analysis and 4 th will be preserved as "Referee" sample with the Department.
18	Cost of samples and testing charges thereof shall be borne by the supplier
19	In case the supplied material, on analytical test, does not conform to the prescribed standards, whole of the batch/lot, as the case may be shall be treated as sub-standard and rejected. In that case an equivalent quantity of standard Plant Protection Chemicals shall have to be replaced by the supplier within fifteen (15) days from the date of issue of notice by the Department at the destination where from the stock was lifted back. Any cost involved for lifting back substandard pesticides and replacement of an equivalent quantity thereof shall be borne by the supplier himself.
20	Technical bids will be opened by the State Level Rate Contract Finalization Committee (SLRCFC) on the same day, or any other working day convenient to the members of the Committee, in presence of tenderers or their representatives who choose to be present.
21	Quantity of the stores indicated is subject to increase or decrease at the discretion of the department without assigning any reason
22	The quotation should be signed by the authorized person and his full name status should be indicated below his signature
23	SLRCFC reserve rights to reject bid even after opening of technical bid or price bid without assigning any reason whatsoever. Further the bid can also be rejected due to delay in submission of documents sought for or if the bidder was defaulter already in the previous transactions of any Government Supplies.
24	10% as security money shall be deposited by the approved tenderer of the material ordered by Indenting Officer
25	The successful tenderer shall not sell the products of same specifications during the relevant period at lower price to any agency than the rates approved by SLRCFC department of Agriculture J&K if so detected action warranted under rules will be initiated against the tenderer beside forfeiture of CDR.



26	The successful bidder shall not assign or transfer this contract or any part of it to other agencies.				
27	The tenderer shall specify the supply point whether local supply or inter state supply and accordingly quote the rate with applicable CST/VAT/taxes and other duties.				
28	The S.L.R.C.F.C. reserves the right to accept or reject any tender , part of a tender ,or all tenders without assigning any reason thereto.

32	The duration between the date of manufacture of the P.P. chemicals and its actual delivery to the Department should not be more than three months for the P.P .Chemicals having shelf life of two years, and 45 days for P.P. Chemicals having shelf life of one year				
33	The successful tenderer shall have to supply the materials strictly as per specifications laid in NIT, within the time schedule given by the Department. In case of failure to make supply in time , the Department shall be at liberty to arrange the material at the risk and cost of successful tenderer, beside forfeiting the C.D.R/FDR, and initiating legal proceedings against the successful tenderer (s) as warranted under rules. In case, the extra cost involved exceeds the CDR amount, the same will be recovered from the defaulting supplier through Land Revenues Act . SLRCFC at its sole discretion has right to empanel more bidders other than the bidder found as L-1 also, so as to enable the department to ensure adequate supply of goods in time as the goods are required to be supplied within the season				
36	If the approved supplier fails to supply the P.P. Chemicals of prescribed specifications /concentration within the prescribed period the Department shall be at liberty to arrange the supplies at its own level from another supplier at the risk and cost of the successful tenderer.				
37	In case the successful tenderer fails to execute the agreement or make supply as ordered ,his CDR shall be forfeited and supplier shall have no claim for its refund/release in any manner. The decision of the Convener S.L.R.C.F.C. Agriculture Department in this regard shall be final and binding upon the supplier . The supplier shall have no right to claim for such refund even in court of law.				
38	If the supplier desires to insure his valuable stocks against any kind of loss, risk etc. under any conditions, the insurance charges will have to be borne by the supplier.				
39	Bank commission charges on account of demand draft against due payment on account of the cost of material shall be borne by the supplier.

42	Ninety percent payment shall be made by the Department after receipt of satisfactory test result of the material supplied & ten percent payment retained from each bill. This 10% payment shall be released within three months from the satisfactorily completion of the contract in full. No interest will be paid by the department on such money.
43	The successful tenderer shall have to enter into an agreement on prescribed performa on non judicial stamp paper of Rs.20/- with the indenting officer before the supply order is issued in his favour for effecting supplies
44	The tenderer shall have to produce a copy of Commercial Tax Clearance certificate issued by the concerned assessing authorities for the period ending March 2011 alongwith tender documents or before finalization of the rates.

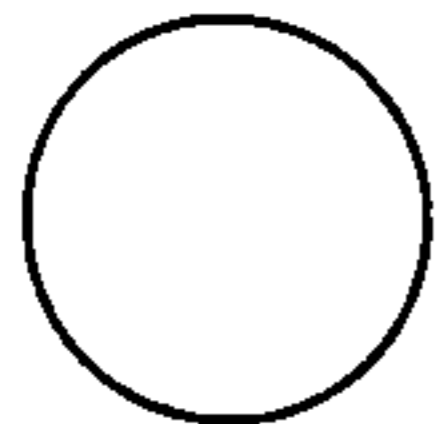
