



FIVE ONLY) ARE INVITED FOR AND ON BEHALF OF GOVERNOR OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR STATE REGARDING PURCHASE OF LOCALLY ADOPTED SAFFRON SEED CORM PLANTING MATERIALS (APPROX. 35 QTLS.) SOWING IN "KISHTWAR DISTRICT" (J&K) AND OTHER NON TRADITIONAL AREAS OF JAMMU REGION FOR DISTRIBUTION UNDER DEPARTMENTAL SUBSIDY PROGRAMMES FOR RABI 2011-12 BY DIRECTORATE OF AGRICULTURE TALAB TILLO, JAMMU.

Tender Notice

Cost of tender Rs.200

Sealed Tenders affixed with revenue stamps worth Rs. 5/-(Rs. Five Only) are invited for and on behalf of Governor of Jammu and Kashmir State regarding purchase of locally adopted **Saffron Seed Corm Planting Materials** sowing in "Kishtwar district" (J&K) and other non traditional areas of Jammu region for distribution under Departmental Subsidy Programmes Rabi 2011-12, by Directorate of Agriculture Talab Tillo, Jammu, as per detail specified below:

Saffron Seed Corms : Tentative quantity : 35 qtls approx.

2.5 cm to 3 Cm Diameter weighing about 8-15 gms. , neat and clean without any trash or dust or disease or under / oversize.

Qty required Approx : 35.00qtls. for Kishtwar district.

*Each tenderer shall deposit 200 gms. sample of neat and clean Saffron Seed Corm to be supplied by the tenderer in a sealed transparent (polythene) perforated cover conforming to the specifications noted above with the Purchase section, Directorate of Agriculture Jammu along with the tender.

**Supply of the Saffron Seed Corm shall be accepted / lifted only after certify the quality i.e disease /damage free and not accompanied with soil by the departmental committee constituted for this purpose

Terms and condition

- 1 The tenders should reach the office of the undersigned by or before ~~4-07~~ 2011 by 01.00 P.M. Through speed post/courier/by hand . Tenders brought by hand shall be put in a TENDER BOX by the concerned tenderer in the office of the undersigned on any working day during office hours upto the said date and time . In case of any gazetted holiday falling on the last date of receipt of tenderers or some holiday suddenly declared by the competent authority under Negotiable Instrument ACT, the next working day shall be treated as the last date of receipt of tenders
- 2 The tenders should be accompanied with a fresh C.D.R. for an amount of 2% cost of material to be supplied subject to minimum of Rs.10,000/- on any scheduled bank and pledged to Accounts Officer Directorate of Agriculture ,Talab Tillo- Jammu.
- 3 The tenders should be neatly written in ink with rates in figures and words. Cutting or overwriting on quoted rates shall not be entertained unless authenticated. Cello tapes be applied on the written rates of tender.
- 4 The tenders will be opened by the Divisional Level Rate Contract Finalization Committee (DLRCFC) on the same day, or any other working day convenient to

the members of the Committee, in presence of tenderers or their representatives who wish to remain present at the time of opening of tenders.

- 5 Conditional tenders shall not be entertained
- 6 The D.L.R.C.F.C. reserves the right to accept or reject any tender, part of a tender, or all tenders without assigning any reason thereto.
- 7 The tender should be super scribed as "Tender for Saffron Corm Seed" to Member Secretary Divisional Level Rate Contract Finalization Committee, Department of Agriculture Talab Tillo, Jammu J&K State
- 8 The rates be quoted on per kg. Basis inclusive of all taxes, Octroi, Toll Tax and other charges with supply to be made F.O.R. Kishtwar (J&K). The rates quoted should in no case exceed the Maximum Retail Price (M.R.P.) Printed on the containers/packing.
- 9 Sample from each lot of seed shall be put to Laboratory test and supply accepted when the test report conforms to the seed standards. The cost of seeds utilized for seed testing shall have to be borne by the approved supplier
- 10 The successful tenderer shall have to supply the material within 20 days from the date of issue of confirm supply order or within a time schedule given by the Department as per the supply order.
- 11 The successful tenderer shall be responsible for proper packing of the seeds to be supplied to avoid damage under normal conditions of transport and delivery of the material in good condition to the consignee at destination. In the event of any damage, Breakage or shortage, the tenderer shall be liable to make good such loss at the time of checking/inspection of the material by the consignee. No extra cost shall be admissible on such account.
- 12 DLRCFC reserves the right to award the tendered goods either in part or full or to empanel on rate contract or follow any other suitable procurement procedure. DLRCFC at its sole discretion has right to empanel more bidders other than the bidder found as L-1 also, so as to enable the department to ensure adequate supply of goods in time as the goods are required to be supplied within the season.
- 13 The supply order shall be executed within time schedule given by the Department. In case of failure to execute the job, the Department shall be at liberty to arrange the material at the risk and cost of successful tenderer and forfeiting the C.D.R, besides initiating legal proceedings against the successful tenderer (s) as warranted under rules. In case, the extra cost involved exceeds the CDR amount, the same will be recovered from the defaulting supplier through Land Revenues Act
- 14 The technical Bid and the financial bid should be sealed by the bidder in separate covers duly super scribed "Tender for supply of Saffron Corm Seed" addressed to Chairman Divisional Level Rate Contract Finalization Committee, Department of Agriculture Talab Tillo Jammu J&K State and both these covers along with E.M.D. are to be put in a bigger cover which should also be sealed. The Technical Bids are to be opened at the first instance and evaluated by competent authority. Financial Bid of only technically acceptable offers will be opened for further evaluation and

- ranking before awarding the contract.
- 15 The approved firm/firms which are empanelled through bidding process shall enter into an agreement on non judicial stamp paper of Rs.20/- with the Indenting Officers, department of Agriculture duly incorporating all the above terms & conditions within seven days from the date of communication before the supply order is issued in his favour for effecting supplies.
- 16 The quantity given in the list for purchase by this Department is tentative and is subject to increase or decrease at the time of issuing supply order
- 17 In Case of dispute the decision of Director Agriculture Jammu (Chairman DLRCFC) shall be final and binding upon both the parties the jurisdiction of legal litigation shall be the courts located at Jammu.
- 18 Legal proceedings ,if any are subject to the jurisdiction of the courts located in the Jammu City, of J&K State.
- 19 Rates approved by Divisional Level Rate Contract Finalization Committee shall remain valid for August-September 2011 sowing .
- 20 After opening of bids if it is detected that rates quoted are not reasonable , DLRCFC reserves right to go for negotiation / re-tender
- 21 All terms and conditions laid in Financial Code of J&K are applicable.
- 22 The tenderer shall give an undertaking on judicial stamp paper of Rs.20/- that the saffron seed corms/planting materials is locally adapted to Kishtwar conditions
- 23 The bidder shall not sell saffron corms during the relevant period at a lower price to any agency than the rates approved by DLRCFC department of Agriculture J&K
- 24 Payment shall be released after obtaining latest No Objection Certificate from Power Dev. Department /Commercial Tax Department with regard to clearance of electric tariff and VAT clearance respectively by Indenting Officer concerned.
