

Short Term Tender Notice

Cost of tender Rs.200/-

Sealed tenders affixed with revenue stamps worth Rs.5/- (Rs. Five only) are invited for and on behalf of Governor of J&K State from the bonafides, registered, resourceful and experienced printers for printing of Soil Health Card (Multicolour, Booklet type) for State Soil Testing Laboratories, Department of Agriculture J&K Jammu Division as per specifications and contents to be printed is given in annexure A. The rates quoted should be F.O.R Talab Tillo Jammu.

Terms and conditions

- 1 The tenders should reach the office of the undersigned by or before 12-03-2011 up to 01.00 P.M through speed post / courier/ by hand. Tenders brought by hand shall be put in a TENDER BOX by the concerned tenderer in the office of the undersigned on any working day during office hours up to the said date and time.. In case of any gazetted holiday falling on the last date of receipt of tenders or some holiday suddenly declared by the competent authority under Negotiable Instrument Act, the next working day shall be treated as the last date of receipt of tenders
- 2 The under mentioned documents / detail must be submitted with tender.
 - A. Registration Certificate of firm
 - B. C.D.R / FDR for an amount of Rs.10,000/-,Pledged to Accounts Officer (Member Secretary DLRCFC) Department of Agriculture, J&K Govt., Talab Tillo-Jammu
 - C. Declaration certificate (for printing) issued by District Magistrate of concerned district.
 - D. Valid CST/VAT and copy of Pan Card copy should be enclosed
 - E. Samples of Material to be applied.
- 3 Successful tenderer shall, get the Proof of the matter, provided by the department for printing in booklet finalized by Indenting Officer before final printing.
- 4 S.S.I. unit holders shall attach C.D.R. as applicable under rules. Besides, they shall attach copy of the registration certificate regarding present working status of their Industrial units issued by the General Manager Department of Industries and commerce of the concerned district where the unit is registered /functioning.
- 5 The tenders should be accompanied with a C.D.R. for an amount of Rs.10000/-,on any scheduled bank and pledged to Accounts Officer (Member Secretary, Divisional Level Rate Contract Finalization Committee (D.L.R.C.F.C.), Department of Agriculture, J&K Govt.,Talab Tillo-Jammu.
- 6 Supply shall be made by successful tenderer with in 12 days from the date of confirm supply order.
- 7 The tenders should be neatly written in ink with rates in figures and words. Cutting or overwriting on quoted rates shall not be entertained unless authenticated. Cello tapes be applied on the written rates of tender.
- 8 The tenders will be opened by the Divisional Level Rate Contract Finalization Committee (DLRCFC) on the same day, or any other working day convenient to the members of the Committee, in presence of tenderers or their representatives who wish to remain present at the time of opening of tenders
- 9 The D.L.R.C.F.C. reserves the right to accept or reject any tender, part of a tender, or all tenders without assigning any reason thereto
- 10 Any condition of PAYMENT IN ADVANCE shall not be accepted
- 11 Conditional tenders shall not be entertained
- 12 Rates shall be quoted by the tenderers against each item as per given Performa

- 13 The successful tenderer shall have to deposit 5 % of the total tendered value in the shape of "Deposit at Call" in any Nationalized Bank having branch at Jammu duly pledged to the Member Secretary DLRCFC Jammu..... as security money within the stipulated date given by the authority after acceptance of rate. If the successful tenderer fails to deposit security money within the stipulated date, the tender shall be treated as invalid and rejected and earnest money deposited shall also be forfeited. Supply order will be issued on receipt of security money.
- 14 Security money will be released after completion of supply order as per NIT and settlement of the final payment. The part supply or incomplete supply or deviation of specification will also invite forfeiting of security money.
- 15 The successful tenderer shall have to supply the material strictly within the time schedule to be given by the Department. In case of failure to make the supply in time, the Department shall be at liberty to arrange the same at the risk and cost of successful tenderer besides forfeiting the C.D.R and initiating legal proceedings against the successful tenderer (s) as warranted under rules. In case, the extra cost involved exceeds the CDR amount, the same will be recovered from the defaulting supplier through Land Revenue Act. The decision of the Chairman D.L.R.C.F.C. Agriculture Department in this regard shall be final and binding upon the supplier. The supplier shall have no right to claim such refund at all.
- 16 The Booklets supplied if not found upto the standard specifications or any other shortcoming shall be rejected outrightly and shall have to be replaced by the suppliers of their own cost and arrangements within seven days from the date of intimation.
- 17 Supply should be completed within ten days from the date of receipt of supply order
- 18 100% payment shall be made by the Department after receipt of satisfactory supply.
- 19 The successful tenderer shall have to enter into an agreement on prescribed performa on non judicial stamp paper of Rs.20/- with the indenting officer before the supply order is issued in his favour for effecting supplies.
- 20 The quantity given in the list for purchase by this Department is tentative and is subject to increase or decrease at the time of issue of supply order
- 21 Rates approved by Divisional Level Rate Contract Finalization Committee shall remain valid for one year from the date of issue of minutes of meeting or till the next rate contract is available
- 22 Doubt/ dispute/ differences arising out of contract entered into between the parties will be referred to chairman D.L.R.C.F.C. Agriculture Department Jammu for decision under J&K Arbitration Act, whose decision shall be final and binding on both parties
- 23 All other terms and conditions laid down in the J&K Financial Code regarding supplies/procurement of stores in Government Department shall be applicable
- 24 Legal proceedings, if any, are subject to the jurisdiction of the courts located in the Jammu city, of J&K State.
